Woodrow Wilson Myers, 93, of Meadowview Terrace, 184 Buffalo Road, died Thursday, April 15, 2010. Mr. Myers was born in News Ferry, VA on November 16, 1916, a son of the late William Madison Myers and the late Minnie Kate Booze Myers. He had lived most of his life in Maryland, Virginia and in Florida. He was of the baptist faith and had retired in 1971 as a Printer with I.B.M. in Washington, D.C. Mr. Myers was married to Christine Anderson Myers, who died on September 6, 2006, and later to Alice Elizabeth Johnson Myers, who died on February 4, 2008.
